REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- **ON-TIME REGISTRATION:** February 22 – March 12
COST: \$56 per exam
- **LATE REGISTRATION:** March 22 – March 26
COST: \$66 per exam
- **STUDENTS WITH FREE/REDUCED LUNCH**
COST PAID ON-TIME: \$13 per exam
COST WITH LATE FEE: \$18 per exam
- **NO CASH!!! CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY!!!** Make checks out to **Bowie High School**. One check for total amount due is preferable. Include student name and student ID in the memo area of the check.
- **WHERE TO REGISTER:** Counseling Office with Mrs. Ashburn.
Students MUST have payment in hand to register. It takes about 5 minutes to fill out the Registration Form and obtain the receipt. Dropping off or mailing a payment will not get you registered for your exams!
